Farnborough Airport Expansion

Churt Parish Council's objection was one of over 3,000 responses that Farnborough Airport received during their recent consultation on their expansion plans. These have helped Farnborough shape their planning application to Rushmoor Borough Council and details of this have now been published on line on Rushmoor's Planning Portal at <https://publicaccess.rushmoor.gov.uk/online-applications/>.

The deadline for comments on the application is Monday 4th December and the Parish Council will be submitting a response. We will update you when this is submitted.
